

Who: Father & Son Camping / Boating Trip (5 years old and up) All boys must be accompanied by their father and know how to swim.

When: Friday, August 7th – Saturday, August 8th

Where: Obey River Campground, Dale Hollow Lake (about 3 miles south of Byrdstown, TN)

What to bring: Tent (If you have space in your tent – find a tentmate!)

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| Sleeping bag | Swim trunks | Towel | SUNSCREEN |
| Fishing poles | Flashlight | Bug spray | Life Jacket |
| Change of clothes | Camp chairs | Pillow | Water shoes |

Friday: We have rented four tent camping sites: #50, #51, #53 & #55. Each site will hold multiple tents. If you arrive before I do, register at the office. The sites are under the name Kenneth Reed. The earliest check in time is 3:00 p.m. The gate to the campground is locked at 10:00 p.m.

Saturday: We will be cooking breakfast Saturday morning. After breakfast we will spend the day boating on Dale Hollow Lake. A Pontoon boat has been rented for Saturday from Sunset Marina in Byrdstown. The boat has a grill on it and we will be cooking out hamburgers for lunch.

Food: Breakfast and lunch are provided on Saturday. You will be responsible for Friday and Saturday evening meals.

Transportation: The church van will leave the building Friday evening around 4:00 pm. Please let Ken Reed know if you will be on the van. If necessary, the van will make a *quick* stop for dinner in Cookeville. It is important that our group carpool as much as possible to minimize the number vehicles at our campsite.

Important safety information: *Anyone in the water must wear a lifejacket.* If anyone has life jackets (any size) please bring them. We are in need of children's life jackets. Swimming is permitted off the boats. ***Fathers will be responsible for their sons at all times.***

Cost: The cost of the weekend is \$25 per person. The cost covers 2 meals (Saturday breakfast & lunch), boat & campsite rental & cost of boat gas & oil. Make checks payable to Southern Hills. **All money must be turned in by July 29th!**

Directions to the campground: Take 840 East to I-40 east to Knoxville. Take I-40 east. Get off at the Hwy 111 / Livingston exit in Cookeville. Take Hwy 111 Northeast to Livingston (approximately 20-25 miles) In Livingston; continue on Hwy 111 northeast 15 miles and follow signs to the campground. *If you reach Byrdstown, you have gone too far. From Byrdstown the campground is south 3 miles on Hwy 111.* (It takes about 2 hours)
