GOSPEL OBEDIENCE

In recent weeks Southern Hills has been blessed to see seven of our precious young people baptized into Christ. We rejoice at this. However, we realize that there are others, both young and not so young, who need to put on Christ in baptism. If you are one of the ones who needs to obey the gospel and you have not done so, why not? Let me ask you some important questions.

Have you not obeyed the gospel because you think that you do not know enough to become a Christian? How much do you have to know before you are ready to obey the gospel? How much did those people on Pentecost know (Acts 2)? The eunuch (Acts 8)? Lydia and her household (Acts 16)? The jailer and his household (Acts 16)? You know that God exists (Gn. 1:1), that Jesus is His Son and our Savior (Mt. 3: 17; Mt. 17: 5; Jn. 4: 42), that without Christ we are lost in sin (Rom. 3: 23), and you know what to do to be saved (Acts 16: 30). Is that not enough?

Have you not obeyed the gospel because you think you are not good enough to become a Christian? When will you be good enough? Will you ever be? It is not a matter of our own goodness, but of Christ's saving blood (Eph. 1: 7). Christ came to call sinners to repentance (Mt. 9: 12-13). "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Tim. 1: 15). Your sense of unworthiness is one of the very things that makes you a candidate for gospel obedience.

Do you not obey the gospel because you believe the Christian life is too hard? The way of sin is hard (Pr. 13: 15). The Lord will be with us as Christians (Mt. 28: 20) to deliver us from temptation (2 Pt. 2: 9), keep us from stumbling (Jd. 24), and strengthen us (Phil. 4: 13).

Do you not obey the gospel now but plan to obey later? When? Why wait? If you say you will obey someday, sometime and some place, remember that someday is not on the calendar, sometime is not on the clock and some place is not on the map. "Behold, now is the acceptable time, behold, now is the time of salvation" (2 Cor. 6: 2).
