**PREACHING**

There are five acts of Christian worship prescribed by the New Testament. These include prayer (1 Th. 5:17), singing (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16), the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7), giving (1Cor. 16:2), and preaching the word (2 Tim. 4:1-5). Each of these is important.

But if someone asks which act is the most important, the answer would most likely be the Lord's Supper based on Acts 20:7. According to that verse the church at Troas assembled on the first day of the week (Sunday) to "break bread." The term refers to the observance of the Lord's Supper.

However, it is important to notice that Paul also preached on that occasion. We cannot say for certain at what time Paul began to speak, but it was likely at an evening hour. Notice that "he prolonged his speech until midnight" (NASB). I doubt if Paul followed George Barna's suggestion that we hold our service to one hour. I also doubt that Paul preached what John Scott called a "sermonette" of no more than twenty minutes.

Why am I writing this? Many important things happen during a church service. Sometimes we are really pushed for time. So more often than not, what gets cut? The sermon time. That is a dangerous trend! I daresay that there is more in the Bible about the preaching of the word than there is about any of the other five acts of worship. That being the case, we must be careful to see that the word is preached (2 Tim. 4:2).
