**The Master and Men**

Mark 3: 7-19, the text for tonight's sermon, continues to emphasize the authority of our Lord, as does the entire Gospel of Mark. Verses 7-9 show that his authority attracted crowds, while verses 10-12 emphasize His authority over disease and demons. Finally, verses 13-19 illustrate His authority in the selection of the twelve apostles.

Through Mark's gospel account we have repeatedly seen the emphasis on the authority of Jesus. We saw His authority over Satan, men, demons and disease. Soon we will see His authority over death.

All of this confirms the claim of Jesus, "All Authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth" (Mt. 28: 18). We can come to God only through Him (Jn. 14: 6).

## ~ The Word of God ~



Hebrews 4: 12-13 is composed of two great points. Verse 12 discusses the word of God, while verse 13 discusses the God of the word. God and His word are inseparable. God speaks to us through His word. What are the characteristics of God's word? It is "living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword." Further, it pierces "even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." What a description! How powerful the word of God is!

While, as stated above, verse 12 refers to the word of God, verse 13 describes the God of the word. What does this verse say about God? First, He sees and knows all. That is the point of verse 13. Because He sees and knows all, He will be (and is) our Judge. He is the One "to whom we must give account."

We will be judged by God through His Son (Acts 10: 42) through His word (Jn. 12: 48; Rev. 20: 11-15). As F.F. Bruce wrote, "We may conceal our inner being from our neighbors, and we can even deceive ourselves; but nothing escapes the scrutiny of God; before Him everything lies exposed and powerless."

As William Barclay put it, "The point of this passage is that the word of God has come to men and the word of God is such that it cannot possibly be disregarded." To paraphrase James Thompson, the greatest need of the church is to be challenged by the word of God.
