It's Bible Bowl Time!

The Southern Hills Bible Bowl study materials have gone Hi-Tech! This year an online Bible Bowl question tool has been developed in lieu of printed study questions. This online study tool will allow our kids to log in, set what chapters they want questions from (and what order), then answer questions. The study tool will keep track of how well they do on each question and on each chapter so they know where to focus. In addition, it will allow the young people to hit the play button to have the question read to them if they have a hard time reading. The first few chapters are available online now! "SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

The Son of God (I)

Jesus asked, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" (Mt. 22:42). How does the Bible answer that question? We will limit our study to the New Testament. The Bible teaches that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. The Bible confirms the Sonship of Jesus in verse after verse.

For example, all four gospel accounts state very early that Jesus is the Son of God (Mt. 2:15; Mk. 1:1; Lk. 1:32, 35; and John 1:49). (See other terms for Jesus in Jn. 1:1, 9, 18, 29, 36 and 41). Others said that Jesus was/is the Son of God. Some examples are the disciples (Mt. 14:33), Peter (Mt. 16:16), Martha (Jn. 11:27), Paul (Acts 9:20, Rom. 1:3-4, Col. 1:13, etc.), Gabriel (Lk. 1:32-33), John the Baptist (Jn. 1:34), the Roman centurion (Mk. 15:39), even Satan (Mt. 4) and his demons (Lk. 4:41). In addition, Jesus' signs confirm his Sonship (Jn. 20:30-31).

Jesus said that he was/is the Son of God. Many times He called God "My Father" (Mt. 7:21; Mt. 10:32-33). He spoke of being about "My Father's business" (Lk. 2:49), of being one with His Father (Jn. 10:30), said He was the Son of God (Jn. 10:36), said He did the works of His Father (Jn. 10:37), and said "believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him" (Jn. 10:38). He said that the Father sent Him (Jn. 8:16, 12:49, 13:3, 16:28, 17:1-5).

The gospel writers acknowledged Jesus as God's Son, many others confessed Him as God's Son, and Jesus Himself made it very clear that He was/is God's Son. (More next week.)
