## ~ Lessons From Life ~

James asks, "What is your life?" He answers, "It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away" (Js. 4: 14 NKJV). In verse 13 James had warned against poor planning. Planning is poor that does not consider the uncertainty of life (4: 14). Proper planning always includes God (4: 15). Further, there is no place in the Christian life for boasting (4: 16). Finally, to know to do good and not do it is sin (4: 17).

Proper planning always includes awareness of--and submission to--God's will. There are three possible attitudes that we can take toward God's will. We can ignore it (4: 13-14, 16), disobey it (4: 17), or obey it (4: 15). Which will we do? Which must Christians do?

What are the lessons we can learn from life, as based on James 4: 13-17? (1) It is good to plan (4: 13). There is nothing wrong with proper planning. Businesses, companies, governments and institutions do it. So should individuals, families and churches. (2) Life is uncertain (4: 14). We are "a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away."

(3) Our plans must include God (4: 15). "If the Lord wills" is not a magic formula that we repeat, but a guideline that controls our life. Is what we are planning to do or want to do God's will? If not, why plan to do it? (4) Do not boast or brag about yourself or your accomplishments (4: 16). Give God the glory. (5) Do good. Not to do good is sin (4: 17). Biblical guidelines for life!
