# \* Stilling The Storms \*

C. S. Lewis defined a miracle as "an interference with nature by supernatural powers." Someone else described a miracle as God's intervention in the world in extraordinary ways for His purposes. The Bible also calls miracles signs, wonders, powers and mighty works. The miracles in the Bible had two purposes. One was to help people with needs. The other is to confirm Jesus as the Son of God (Jn. 20: 30-31).

There are many great miracles of Jesus in the Bible. One is His stilling of the storm (Mk. 4: 35-41). Jesus and those with Him crossed the Sea of Galilee in a boat. As Jesus was asleep on a pillow in the stern of the boat, "a great windstorm arose." The storm was so intense that "the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling."

The disciples cried, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" So Jesus woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" As a result "the wind ceased, and there was a great calm." What happened caused the disciples to exclaim, "Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!"

Three points stand out here. The first is the POWER of Jesus. He controlled nature. Second is the PRESENCE of Jesus. He was there with His disciples and He is with us (Mt. 28: 20). Third is the PEACE that comes from Jesus. These are the thoughts we will study this morning.
