## ~ The Return of Christ ~

The second coming of Christ is one of the most important doctrines in the Bible. There are over 300 references to it in the New Testament. About one verse out of every twenty-five in the New Testament refers to it either directly or indirectly. It is a most important doctrine. Jesus Himself promised His return (Jn. 14: 1-3). He warned us to be ready (Mt. 24-25). We cannot examine every passage in the New Testament that teaches this great truth, but we can study one (1 Thess. 4: 13-18). What does it teach about the return of our Lord?

Five points stand out in this passage. First, there is the PROBLEM. Paul did not want the Thessalonians to be ignorant about those Christians who had died (4: 13). Would they miss the return of Jesus? So Paul presented a PROPOSAL (4:14). He supported this proposal with PROOF "by the word of the Lord" (4:15). Then he described the PROCEDURE for the second coming (4:16). Next he stated the PROMISE that we would "meet the Lord in the air" (4:17).

Note that there is nothing here or elsewhere in the Bible that supports such ideas as a rapture, thousand year reign or the other false teachings on this matter. An entire system of erroneous doctrine has been built on the SILENCE of Scripture.

Finally, Paul concludes, "Comfort one another with these words" (4:18).
