One Another

God's answer to incivility is to consider one another. Awareness of others—their presence, feelings, and needs—is fundamental to civility in society and to Christlikeness in your soul. Before you can love others, you must first notice them and think about them. It is striking how many “one another” passages there are in God's Word. Clearly, He wants you to understand that sin and incivility result from overlooking or injuring others. Those who ignore or abuse people displease God Who created them in His image. Consequently, the Lord filled the Bible with admonitions to be mindful of others. Citizens of heaven possess a one another mindset that distinguishes them as God's children. As you meditate on the Bible's one another passages and faithfully practice them, you increasingly resemble the Lord. Thus, Heaven's antidote to rudeness is simple: follow Jesus' example and teachings. The more you walk in His footsteps, the more thoughtful and kind you are. The more observant and caring you become, the more you bring a little heaven to earth.
