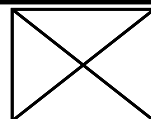

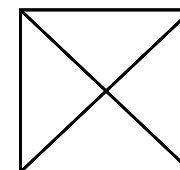

Cara Messmer recently spent a week working at the City of Children, [www.cityofchildren.com](http://www.cityofchildren.com), in Ensenada, Baja Mexico. Supported by the churches of Christ, this orphanage serves almost 100 children who have been orphaned, abandoned, or abused. The Youth News (YN) interviewed Cara to learn more about her trip.

YN: Was this your first trip to the City of Children?  
 CM: No, I went last year as well. Every year, a group of students and faculty from Columbia Academy go during spring break. This year over 50 went to the City of Children and another group of 10 or so went to another area of Mexico.

YN: What types of activities did you do?

CM: We would work during the day while the children were at school. We would take food to families, pour concrete or just help around the campus. Once the children got home, we would play with them and we put on a VBS in the evening.

YN: What did you enjoy the most?

CM: The kids -- several of them really stick in my mind.

YN: What did you miss the most?

CM: Hot showers! And good water pressure!

YN: Are you glad you went?

CM: Yes! I wish I had gone all four years.

## ~ The Final Week ~

Over the next several Sunday mornings the sermons will focus on the final week in the life of Jesus. We will start today by focusing on the events leading up to and including His arrest. What is different in this series from earlier series on the same subject is that the sermons will be taken largely from the gospel of Mark, which we have been studying over the last several weeks.

Today we will begin with a look at the three predictions or prophecies Jesus makes in Mark 8:31, 9:31 and 10:32-34. This will be followed by a brief look at Mark 14:1, where the chief priests and scribes plot to kill the Lord. Then we will go to Mark 14:12 for a brief mention of the Passover, which includes another reference to His death (14:21). This is followed by a reference to the Lord's Supper, which includes a promise of His resurrection (14:28).

After remembering the prayer of Jesus in Gethsemane (14:32-42) we will come to the events that include His betrayal and arrest (14:43-52). Next Lord's Day morning we will look at the trials of Jesus. That will be followed by a study of the crucifixion of Jesus (April 17), His resurrection (April 24) and His ascension (May 1).

These events are at the heart of the gospel of Christ (1 Cor. 15:1-4). That is why we need to study them. Our prayer is that they will draw us closer to the Lord and help us appreciate even more what He did for us.
