## ~ The Trial of Jesus ~

Last Sunday morning we studied the events leading up to and including the betrayal and arrest of Jesus. This morning we will examine the trial (or more correctly trials) of our Lord. Those who arrested Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane first took Him to Annas, the father-in-law of Caiaphas who was the high priest that year (Jn. 18: 13-14).

Annas then sent Jesus to Caiaphas the high priest (Jn. 18: 24). False witnesses were brought forward to testify against Jesus, but none of them told the truth (Mt. 26: 60; Mk. 14: 56). Men spit on Him, hit Him and taunted Him.

Then they led Jesus away to Pilate, the Roman governor of Judea (Mt. 27: 2). Whereas the Jews had accused Jesus of blasphemy, the charge they brought against Him before Pilate was treason (Lk. 22: 71; Lk. 23: 2). After the first interrogation of Jesus by Pilate, the governor sent Jesus to Herod (Lk. 23: 7-12). Herod, after questioning and mocking Jesus, sent Him back to Pilate.

Now Jesus stood before Pilate for another round of questioning. But Pilate "found no fault in this man" (Lk. 23: 14). So Pilate proposed to chastise and release Jesus. He gave the mob a choice of freeing Jesus or Barabbas. They chose the latter. "So Pilate, wanting to gratify the crowd, released Barabbas to them; and he delivered Jesus, after he had scourged Him, to be crucified" (Mk. 15: 15).
