The Resurrection of Christ

His disciples took the lifeless body of Jesus down from the cross, hastily prepared it for burial, and placed it in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea. Then they went away to mourn. Pilate, at the request of the chief priests and Pharisees, sealed a stone across the opening of the tomb and placed a guard by it.

Early Sunday morning some women who were disciples of Jesus came to the tomb to anoint the Lord's body, only to be greeted by two angels, one of whom told them that Jesus had risen. The tomb was empty! The women ran back to tell the disciples. One of those women, Mary Magdalene, told Peter and John of what they had seen and heard. The two disciples ran to the tomb and, just as the women had said, found it empty. The grave clothes in which Jesus had been buried were there, but the Lord was not. He had risen!

The resurrected Jesus was seen by many eyewitnesses, including Mary Magdalene (Jn. 20: 11-18), the two disciples on the Emmaus road (Lk. 24: 13-35), the disciples assembled in the upper room (Mk. 16: 14), the disciples, including Thomas, assembled in that same room one week later (Jn. 20: 26-29), the disciples at the Sea of Tiberias (Jn. 21: 1-24), and the disciples on the mountain (Mt. 28: 16-20).

Paul mentions several resurrection appearances, including more than five hundred brethren at one time (1 Cor. 15: 6), James (1 Cor. 15: 7), and Paul himself (1 Cor. 15: 8-11). These two points confirm the resurrection of Christ: the EMPTY TOMB and the EYEWITNESSES.
