"SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

PEACE

The Bible uses the word peace in several different ways. It can refer to a harmonious relationship between and among men, between and among nations, within the church or within one's heart and mind. Notice three very important things the Bible teaches about peace.

One, Jesus promised spiritual peace to His disciples (Jn. 14: 27). He said, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you." Then He added, "Not as the world gives do I give to you." The world may promise us peace, but it cannot keep its promise. But Christ can! Therefore, Jesus adds, "Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." (See John 14: 1). Why should we not be agitated or fearful? Because Christ gives us peace.

Two, this promise is further confirmed in John 14: 33, where Jesus warns, "In the world you will have tribulation." We are all well aware of that, aren't we? "But," Jesus adds, "be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." We are to "take heart" or "cheer up." Why? Because He has "overcome the world." He has already conquered the world.

Third, our peace comes from God through Christ (Rom. 5: 1). Therefore, we are not to be anxious, but we are to depend on God (Phil. 4: 4-7). Why? Because our peace comes from God. He is its source. And what does this peace do? (1) It "surpasses all understanding." (2) It "guards (builds a fortress around) our hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." What is it? It is the peace that comes from God through Christ.
