OUR CHALLENGE

Many people drive by this building every day. Few of them know much about this church; some know little or nothing. We have much in common with these people. We have families, debts, goals, wishes and dreams. We and they get tired, worry, and want. We mow our lawns, eat our meals, gain weight (or lose it), fear terrorism, like sports, like to laugh and to think. We are so much alike.

What is the main difference between us and them? While some, perhaps many, of them know about the Lord, probably not many of them know Him. In fact, many of those who do not know the Lord do not even know that they need the Lord. If we were to do a survey of those who drive by here and asked them what they know about Jesus, many of them would have to admit that they do not know much, while others would have to admit that they know nothing at all.

How are we to deal with such people? How do we react to them? Do we leave them alone and let them go on their way? Or do we become the aggressive church Jesus expects us to be and reach out to them to tell them about Jesus? This morning we are studying Colossians 4:2-6. It says that we must do two things. (1) We must talk to the Lord about the lost. (2) We must talk to the lost about the Lord. That is our mission, purpose and challenge.
