~ Supper, Garden and Betrayal ~

Tonight we will continue our study of the last week in the earthly life of Jesus as we look at three important events from that last week: Passover and the Lord's Supper, the Garden of Gethsemane and our Lord's betrayal by Judas Iscariot. These events are recorded in Mark 14: 12-42.

First, Jesus observed Passover with His disciples (Mk. 14: 12-21). Then He instituted the Lord's Supper (Mk. 14: 22-26). The Supper was followed by the Lord's warning of what was to happen, His promise to rise again, and His warning of Peter's denials of Him (vs. 27-31). Of course the New Testament church still observes the Lord's Supper today (1 Cor. 11: 17-34).

Then Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane, where He prayed three times that, if possible, the cup of death, of which He was about to partake, might pass from Him. In the Wednesday night auditorium Bible class we have been studying, among other things, the humanity of Jesus. Nowhere is His humanity more evident than in His prayers there in the garden. He asked the Father to "remove this cup from Me; yet not what I will, but what You will" (v. 36).

Finally, tonight we will look at the betrayal of Jesus by Judas Iscariot (vs. 42-52). Judas had agreed to betray Jesus for thirty pieces of silver (Mt. 26: 15; Zech. 11: 12), the price for the lowest common slave. Judas betrayed Jesus with a kiss (v. 44-45). Then those led by Judas took Jesus away to kill Him.
