~ God's Will ~

How can we know God's will? By reading God's word, the Bible. The Bible reveals the mind, heart and will of God. Truth is transmitted to us from God. It begins with God Himself (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). Jesus is truth embodied (Jn. 14: 6). Jesus promised to send "the Helper" to us (Jn. 16: 7). The Helper is the Holy Spirit, who "will guide you into all truth" (Jn. 16: 13). The Holy Spirit guided the apostles and other Bible writers into "all truth" (Jn. 16: 13). The inspired writers of the Bible recorded the truth (Lk. 24: 49; Jn. 16: 13; Acts 2: 1-11; Gal. 1: 11-12; 1 Cor. 2: 6-16).

When we read the Bible we can be assured that we are reading the truth that was and is revealed to us by God (Ps. 119: 105). It is this truth, the will of God, that must be read, studied, understood and obeyed (Mt. 7: 21). No Christian or church can be any stronger in the faith or more mature spiritually than its knowledge of, and obedience to, the Bible. We must know God's word to live by God's word. We must know God's word to teach God's word to others.

In 1962 I had the privilege of working with a group on a campaign for Christ in Glasgow, Scotland. For many years Glasgow's motto was "Let Glasgow flourish by the preaching of the word." Later, however, the motto was shortened to simply "Let Glasgow flourish." Christ's church will flourish only by the preaching, teaching and living of God's word.

First, Paul was an apostle who was inspired by the Spirit of God (Gal. 1: 11-12; 2 Tim. 3: 16-17). Second, Paul taught the truth to Timothy, who had heard many things from Paul among many witnesses. Third, Timothy was to commit these truths to faithful men. Fourth, these men were to teach the truth to others also. These are the four fundamental steps in the Christian teaching process.

Southern Hills is blessed with a large number of excellent Bible teachers. Every class, from the youngest up, is taught by teachers who are both knowledgeable and prepared. We thank our teachers for the great job they do!
