## The Miracles of Jesus

In recent weeks in our Sunday morning sermons we have been studying some of the miracles of Jesus. We have seen that He had power over nature (the stilling of the storm), over disease (the healing of the man born blind), and over demons (we saw several examples). Today we will see that Jesus had power over death as He gave life to the son of the widow from Nain and to the daughter of Jairus. These miracles are very important because they, like all the other miracles performed by Jesus, show not only His compassion, but also His power and authority.

When Jesus healed the man in the synagogue at Capernaum who was possessed by the spirit of an unclean demon, Luke says, "And amazement came upon them all, and they began talking with one another saying, What is this message? For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits and they come out" (Luke 4: 36). Notice that Jesus had both the power and the authority. In other words He had both the ability and the right to do what He did because He is the Son of God (Mt. 28:18).

Next Wednesday night, February 25, is the last service in our special series with Brad Harrub. Brad has done a splendid job, as we knew he would. We appreciate his great work! The following Wednesday night, March 4, we begin a special three-week series on parenting in a class taught in the fellowship hall by Ron Maynard. These classes are to help you live a faithful Christian life and be a better servant in the kingdom of God. We encourage you to take advantage of them and of all services and classes offered at Southern Hills.
