JUSTIFIED BY FAITH

One of the great doctrines of the New Testament is justification by faith (Romans 3: 21-26; Romans 5: 1; Galatians 2: 16). However, it is one of the most misunderstood doctrines in the Bible. What is it and what does it mean? Justification is "the act, process, or state of being justified by God" (Webster). It is "the act of pronouncing righteous" (Vine). A more detailed definition says, "It is thus a declarative act of the God of grace by which He declares sinners free from the guilt and consequences of their sin through faith in the atonement of Christ" (Petersen).

Wayne Jackson notes the importance of the doctrine when he states that the noun justification is found 92 times in the New Testament, while the verb justify occurs 39 times. Jackson adds, "Justification is the legal standing that results from the process of being justified. To say that one is justified from sin is not to claim that he is innocent of the crime; far from it. Rather, the term suggests that the offender has been exempted from the penalty he justly deserves." He concludes, "Justification is the equivalent of forgiveness."

In this morning's sermon we will ask three questions: (1) What is justification and what does it mean to be justified? (2) What is faith and faith in whom? (3) What is the result of justification? We will study primarily (though not exclusively) the three passages cited above. Please have your Bible open and be ready to study with us.
