The Cross of Christ



Over the last several weeks we have studied some of the miracles of Christ in a series of Sunday morning sermons. We have seen that he has power over nature, disease, demons, death and sin. These miracles emphasize His power and authority (Lk. 4: 36). They confirm the fact that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, and the Savior of the world (Jn. 3:16; 1 Jn. 4:14).

Today we begin a series of four sermons that will focus on the cross of Christ. Today's lesson concerns the statements made by both Jesus and the prophets that there would be a cross on which the Son of God, the Messiah, would die to save us from sin.

It is imperative that we and all men hear and understand the message of the cross. Why? Because the cross, along with the burial and resurrection of Jesus, stands at the center of our faith. God so loved us that He gave His Son to die for us.

Thus Peter wrote, "Christ suffered for you" (1 Pt. 2: 21). Three verses later he added of Jesus, "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross" (1 Pt. 2: 24). The word "for" means "on behalf of." Christ died for us, on our behalf, in our place. As Leon Morris wrote, "The cross dominates the New Testament." In fact, it is one of the major keys to the whole plan of redemption.
