The Church Christ Built



Today we begin a series of sermons on the church Christ built. The series will be preached on Sunday mornings. I am going to preach TO the church ABOUT the church. Today we will begin by defining the word, then looking at some of the OT prophecies regarding the church. We will see how and when the church was established and then study the characteristics of Christ's church. Among those are the facts that His church was built by Christ (Mt. 16:18) and purchased with His blood (Acts 20:28). The NT church is the body of Christ (Eph. 1:22-23) and the saved are added to it (Acts 2:47).

Later sermons will include "God's Plan for His Church" (Eph. 4:11-13), "How To Have A Great Church" (Eph. 4:14-16), "A New Man" (Eph. 4:17-24), "Imitators of God" (Eph. 4:25-32), "Walk In Love" (Eph. 5:1-7), "Walk In Light" (Eph. 5:8-14), and "Walk In Wisdom" (Eph. 5:15-21). I hope this series will be a great blessing to Southern Hills. I pray that it will cause us as individual Christians and as a church to grow "to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ" (Eph. 4:13).

Over the past several months we have tried to emphasize the importance of evangelism. For the next several weeks we will emphasize the importance of both our individual spiritual growth and the growth of the body. We hope you will be here at every service to consider the importance of these thoughts.
