** CHILDREN OF GOD **

Last week we saw that Paul's life was lived "by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me" (Gal. 2: 20). Christ died in our place, "having become a curse for us" (Gal. 3: 13). Thus, Paul would boast only "in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Gal. 6: 14).

The week before that we saw that we are justified by (the) faith in Christ (Gal. 2: 16). Two weeks before that we saw that there is only one gospel, the gospel of Christ, that must be preached, believed and obeyed (Gal. 1: 6-10). Today we will see what it means to be the children of God and how we become such (Gal. 3: 26-29). The sermon will make three points. (1) We are the children of God through Christ (Gal. 3: 26). (2) We are "clothed" with (or "have put on") Christ (Gal. 3: 27). (3) We are one in Christ (Gal. 3: 28-29).

Tonight our guest speaker is B. Ratnam, a gospel preacher who lives and works in India. Brother Ratnam has been a Christian since 1972. He was a government official and educator for almost fifty years, and has been widely recognized in his country for his work in benevolence and education.

However, brother Ratnam's most valuable asset is his humility and his love for both the Lord and the lost. He has been responsible for leading literally thousands of people to Christ. We hope you will be here tonight to hear him speak and to learn more about the work for the Lord we help support in India.
