Christ and His Church (2)

Last Sunday, as we studied Christ and His church, we saw that the church was DEFINED and PROPHESED. Today we will see that the church was PROMISED as we study the words of Jesus in Matthew 16: 13-18. After Peter's confession of Jesus (Mt. 16:16), our Lord promised to build his church.

Jesus is both architect and builder of His church (Mt. 16:18). He is its purchaser (Acts 20:28) He is its Head (Eph. 1:22-23). He is its Savior (Eph. 5:23).

However, we do not call the church the church of Christ simply because of Romans 16:16 (though that is a good reason). The key is in Matthew 16:18, where Jesus calls the church "My church." The Nestle text has "of Me the church," which could be rendered "the church of Me." Whose church? The church of Christ. Why? Because the church belongs to Christ for the reasons stated above (architect, builder, purchaser, body, Head, Savior).

Paul lists what are sometimes called "The Seven Ones" (Eph. 4:4-6). Among these is the "one body" (4:4). If there is one body, and the body is the church, then there is one church. That does not refer to the many denominations (a word suggesting division), but to the one New Testament church, the Lord's church. If not, why not?
