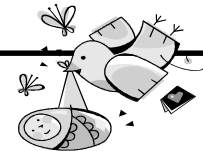

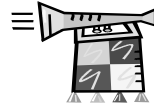

~ Worship ~



Today we are beginning a series of four Sunday morning sermons on worship. They are "Who We Worship", "Why We Worship", and two sermons on "How We Worship". What is worship? Webster defines it as "reverence offered a divine being" and "an act expressing such reverence." Someone has said that the word refers to someone who is worthy of our worship (worthship), who is Jehovah God.

Today we will study Paul's sermon before the Aeropagus on Mars Hill to see what it tells us about the God we worship. He is the Creator (Acts 17: 24), the Giver of all good things (17: 25), the One who controls the worlds (17: 26), and the God who has revealed Himself (17: 27-28). He is "the living and true God" (1 Thess. 1: 9). There is "one God and Father of all" (Eph. 4: 6) and we are to worship Him (Mt. 4: 10).

The greatest purpose of our lives is to have fellowship with God. We can do this only through Christ (Jn. 14: 6; 1 Jn. 1: 3, 7). What are some ways we can draw closer to God? One is through prayer. We are to "pray without ceasing" (1 Thess. 5: 17). A second is through study of God's word (2 Tim. 2: 15) and meditation on it (Ps. 1: 2; Phil. 4: 8). A third is through worship (Heb. 10: 25). A fourth is through regular and proper observance of the Lord's Supper (Acts 20: 7). A fifth is through giving (1 Cor. 16: 2). A sixth is through singing (Eph. 5: 19; Col. 3: 16). Please do these regularly and faithfully to draw closer to God.
