**HOW DID JESUS DIE?**

Today's sermon is the fourth and final lesson in the series on the cross of Christ. We will begin by looking at the events that led up to the cross, especially the events of the last night and day of our Lord's life. Then we will review the actual event of the crucifixion itself. These are the last hours of our Lord's earthly life. He is within fifteen hours of the cross and within twenty-four hours of His death and burial.

Jesus is only about thirty years of age and He is about to die, not for any sins or crimes of His own, for there were none (Heb. 4: 15). He is about to die for our sins and the sins of the world (Jn. 3: 16-17).

We will briefly mention the institution of the Lord's Supper and the prayers in the garden. Then we will look at His betrayal and arrest, followed by His "trials" before Annas, Caiaphas and the Sanhedrin. We will cover His interrogations by Pilate, interrupted by His interview before Herod. Finally we will hear the sentence of condemnation pronounced on Him.

We will conclude the lesson by thinking about the indignities He suffered from the Roman soldiers and His crucifixion on Golgotha. As we go through this terrible ordeal with Jesus we want everyone to remember that this happened for us. As you think about what happened on that great and terrible day, remind yourself, "He did that for me! He died for me!" That is the message of the cross.
