Services for the Hearing Impaired

The Heart of the Gospel

This morning we conclude a series of sermons on the cross of Christ by looking at the events that were a part of the crucifixion of our Lord. Last week we looked at those events that led up to Golgotha. Today we look at what happened on that barren and bleak hill on that great and terrible day. This series will be followed by a series of at least three sermons on the resurrection of Jesus.

These great truths of the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord are the very heart and core of the Christian faith (1 Cor. 15: 3-4). Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose again the third day. And all of this was "according to the Scriptures." (See Gen. 3: 15, Psalm 22, Isaiah 53). They are at the heart of the gospel Paul preached (1 Cor. 15: 1-2).

Further, the crucified and resurrected Christ was seen by eyewitnesses. Among those Paul mentions Cephas, the twelve, over five hundred brethren at once, James, all the apostles, and Paul himself. Without the death of Christ there could be no forgiveness of sins (Eph. 1:7). Without the resurrection of Christ there would be no hope of eternal life.

We must always continue to believe in, preach and teach the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus. A reporter asked a famous theologian if one could be a Christian without believing in the resurrection of Jesus. The theologian affirmed that one could. That is nonsense! How could one believe in and follow a non-resurrected Jesus? He was "declared to be the Son of God with power according to the spirit of holiness by the resurrection from the dead" (Rom. 1:4). The resurrected Jesus is the reigning Lord.
