SECRETARY: Pam Cost Today we continue our study of the trials of life. So far (from James 1) we have seen that trials should bring joy (1: 2). Trials test our faith and produce endurance or patience (1: 3). They are to make us "perfect and complete, lacking in nothing" (1: 4). To endure and overcome our trials successfully we need wisdom, prayer, and faith (1: 5-8). God, who makes it possible through Christ for the brother of humble circumstances to glory in his high position and the rich man to glory in his humiliation, will through Christ bless us in and through our trials (1: 9-11).

Today we will examine James 1: 12. It tells us that the man who perseveres under trial will be approved by God. As a result "he will receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to those who love Him." Four key words stand out in this verse (for our study). They are persevere, approved, receive and promised. If we persevere we will be approved. If we are approved we will receive the crown of life. That crown has been promised to us, those who love Him, by God.

Some have suggested that James 1: 12 is a transition verse that leads from a discussion of trials to a discussion of temptation (1: 13-15). That makes sense. Today, then, we conclude our study of trials. Next Sunday we begin our study of temptation. Both of these, trials and temptations, are very important biblical subjects.

Tonight we will see "Four Reasons for Righteousness" (2 Timothy 2: 8-10).
