PROVIDENCE

Webster defines providence as “divine guidance or care.” Parker notes that the word itself does not appear in the Bible, but the term represents a truly biblical doctrine. As he concludes, “The doctrine of providence tells us that the world and our lives are not ruled by chance or by fate but by God.” He adds, “Providence is God’s activity through His unlimited power and knowledge to fulfill His purpose for the whole creation, including man.”

The word literally means to see before or foresee. Erickson says that providence is “the continuing action of God by which He preserves in existence the creation He has brought into being, and guides it to His intended purposes for it.” He adds that providence “is central to the conduct of the Christian life. It means that we are able to live in the assurance that God is present and active in our lives.”

We are thinking about the providence of God and how it works in our lives. This morning we will study Romans 8:28, one of the greatest and most reassuring verses in the Bible on this topic. Tonight we will look at Romans 8: 31-39. These passages assure us that God is at work in our lives to bring about His will.

The providence of God (1) glorifies God as it promotes His purpose. (2) It is a great comfort to those who are the called. This is an introduction to the topic of God’s providence.
