The Church Established

The church of Christ was established on the first Pentecost after the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the tomb. It was established in Jerusalem, in keeping with the prophecies of Isaiah 2, Micah 4, Joel 2 and Daniel chapters 2 and 7. The church was designed by God according to His eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11). It was built by Jesus Christ in keeping with His promise (Mt. 16: 18). It was built on the foundation fact that he is the Christ, the Son of the living God (Mt. 16:16).

The risen Jesus told the apostles to "tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued (clothed) with power from on high" (Lk. 24:49). The power came when the Holy Spirit came (Acts 1:8). The Holy Spirit came on that Pentecost mentioned above (Acts 2:1-13). That event, according to Peter, was "what was spoken by the prophet Joel" (Acts 2:17-21; Joel 2:28-32). The events of Acts 2 fulfilled the prophecies of Joel, Isaiah, Micah, Daniel and others. The prophecies concerning the establishment of Christ's church were fulfilled on that Pentecost day (Acts 2).

It was on that day that the gospel of Christ was first preached (Acts 2:14-40). On that day many obeyed the gospel of Christ (Acts 2:41). The church of our Lord was born! The faithfulness of the NT church is described in Acts 2:42-47. Does that church exist today? Can it be restored today? Yes! How? By following the inspired word of God!
