“What Must I Do?”

One of the most important questions ever asked was, “What must I do to be saved?” (Acts 16: 30). It is the question we will ask and answer in this morning’s sermon. First, look at the SITUATION. The Philippian jailer knew that he was lost, but did not know what to do to be saved. However, after listening to Paul and Silas praying and singing hymns to God, he knew they could answer his question. The jailer was lost in sin (Rom. 3: 23, 5: 12, 6: 23; Ezek. 18: 18).

Second, sin leads to CONDEMNATION. The gospel is “the power of God unto salvation” (Rom. 1: 16). One who does not obey the gospel “will be condemned” (Mk. 16: 16). “There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus” (Rom. 8: 1). But what about those who are not in Christ? The answer is painfully clear because “No one comes to the Father except through Me” (Jn. 14: 6).

Thirdly, the situation does not have to lead to condemnation. It can lead to SALVATION. Christ came to save us from our sins (Jn. 3: 16-17; Lk. 19: 10). He came to bring redemption. What is redemption? “The forgiveness of sins” (Eph. 1: 7; Col. 1: 14). That redemption is made possible “through His blood” (Eph. 1: 7; Mt. 26: 28). He is “the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (Jn. 1: 29).

What must YOU do to be saved? Hear (Rom. 10: 17), believe (Jn. 8: 24), repent (Lk. 13: 3, 5), confess His name (Rom. 10: 10) and be immersed for the remission of sins (Acts 2: 38). Please obey the Lord today!
