The Resurrection Life

The sermon this morning will discuss the resurrection life. By this I do not mean the life we will live after we have been raised from the dead and given our resurrection bodies, as important as that is. In fact, we discussed that last Sunday night. Today's lesson deals with the kind of life we are to live in this world in view of the fact that we will be raised from the dead when the Lord comes again (Jn. 14: 1-3; 1 Cor. 15: 20-23).

The text for today's study is Philippians 3. We will see four things: (1) What Paul lost (Phil. 3: 1-6), (2) What Paul gained (3: 7-11), (3) Why we should faithfully follow Christ (3: 12-19), and (4) What awaits us if we do (3: 20-21). We will pay especially close attention to Philippians 3: 20-21, which describes the transformation of our humble bodies "into conformity with the body of His glory."

What does Paul mean when he says that the Lord will "transform" our bodies? The word means to transform, make or change. It refers here to the time when the Lord is "to change our lowly body to be like the glorious body" of Christ (BAGD). (See 1 John 3: 1-3). How will this change take place? "By the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself." (See Romans 1: 4).

The last sermon in this series on the resurrection is scheduled for next Sunday night, when we will discuss "The Resurrection Promise," based on 1 Corinthians 15: 50-58. We hope you will be here to hear that sermon also.
