A Mother's Influence

Today we honor Christian mothers. It has been said that mothers hold "the most influential position on the planet." Not some CEO, politician, entertainer or athlete, but Christian mothers. We salute you and we thank God for you. Your love, influence and example remain with your children all of their days. There is not a child whose life is not touched by their mother.

The Bible contains several examples of godly mothers, one of whom was Timothy's mother, Eunice. In fact, Timothy was fortunate enough to have the godly influence of both his mother and his grandmother to shape his life (2 Tim. 1: 5, 3:14-17). While Timothy's mother and grandmother were Christians (Acts 16: 1, 2 Tim. 1:5), his father was not (Acts 16: 1, 3).

Historians say that in Greek homes the father was usually the dominant influence on the children, especially the sons. But Timothy's father did not teach him about Christ.

Who did? His mother and grandmother (2 Tim. 3: 14-15). These two Christian ladies were the most important influences on young Timothy, and their influence continued throughout his life. What kind of young man was Timothy? He was "well spoken of by the brethren" (Acts 16: 2). Why? Because of the teaching and influence of his mother and grandmother. Thank God for Christian mothers and grandmothers. We appreciate you and we salute you today and every day for your work for Christ and with your families.
