"You Are The Christ"

Mark 8 has been called "a pivotal chapter" in Mark's gospel account, "a major turning point" and "the center of Mark's narrative." It answers "the central question of Mark's gospel." In fact, J.W. McGarvey said that "the world's greatest question" is asked and answered in Mark 8. That question is "Who is Jesus?" We will look at that question tonight as we study Mark 8: 27-30.

The passage is divided into four parts: (1) The Question (v. 27), (2) The Confusion (v. 28), (3) The Confession (v. 29) and (4) The Prohibition (v. 30). Actually there are two questions. The first is "Who do people say that I am?" Jesus is asking about people in general. Who do the "crowds" (Lk. 9: 18, Nestle) say He is? The confusion is evident by the various answers given (v. 28). Some say He is John the Baptist, others Elijah, others Jeremiah, and others one of the prophets.

Then comes the most important question. "Who do you say that I am?" (v. 29). Peter answers, "You are the Christ." As Matthew puts it, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (16: 16). Others in Mark have already confessed who Jesus is (Mk. 1:1; 1:24, 34; 3:12; 5:7; Mk. 1:11).

Finally comes the prohibition. The disciples are to "tell no one about Him" (v. 30). But now the world knows. He is the Christ, the Son of God.
