On January 14, 1986, three families met to discuss the possibility of starting a new congregation of the Lord's church in this area of Franklin. Forty people gathered on the first Sunday night in June of that same year in a basement meeting room of the First Tennessee Bank on the square in downtown Franklin. Some of you were present.

By September of 1986 the new church was meeting for all services at the bank. Jerry Slatton was the first regular minister, though others preached for the new church at various times.

One year later (1987) the church purchased property on the Goose Creek By-Pass and converted a garage into a meetinghouse. The first meeting at this new location was on November 29, 1987. Ground breaking for the present auditorium took place on November 9, 1992, and the first assembly in the new auditorium was on a Wednesday night, November 3, 1993. The new addition to the building, which includes a fellowship hall, classrooms, offices and a library, was completed in 2000.

These twenty-three years have been filled with good things. Our present is filled with peace, harmony and stability. Our future is promising. We look forward to continuing by God's grace to glorify Him and His Son and to bring lost souls to Christ. And we pledge ourselves to remain faithful to the plea to restore New Testament Christianity, so help us God. HAPPY ANNIVERSARY!
