Encouragement

Webster defines encouragement as the act of encouraging or the state of being encouraged. It is to give hope or promise to someone about something. To encourage is to inspire with courage, spirit or hope, to spur on, to give help to someone. All of us need encouragement, both on a regular basis and at special times in our lives.

Christians need encouragement. From where does our encouragement come? First and foremost it comes from God through His inspired word. Repeatedly the Bible tells us to “be strong and of good courage” (Deut. 31; Josh. 1). The psalmist said, “Be of good courage” (Ps. 27: 14; 31: 24), as did Isaiah (41: 6). Barnabas was called “the Son of Encouragement” (Acts 4:36). To have courage or to receive encouragement is to be strong. As Christians we are to be strong in the faith.

The Greek words for courage indicate good cheer, boldness and confidence. The Greek word for encouragement means to urge or persuade one forward, to exhort, counsel, advise, comfort or encourage. It is easy to see how important courage and encouragement are to the child of God.

One of the ways we encourage other Christians and are encouraged by them is by our faithful attendance at all of the worship and Bible study periods of the church. We are encouraged to not forsake “the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching” (Heb. 10: 25 NKJV).
