TRUTH AND TRADITION

Pontius Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?" (Jn. 18: 38). Jesus had already said that God's word is truth (Jn. 17: 17). He had also said, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free" (Jn. 8: 31-32). What do these verses tell us? (1) God's word is truth. (2) We must continue in His word if we are to be His disciples. (3) His word, the truth, will make us free. Free from what? Sin, error, condemnation and death.

What is tradition? Sometimes the word is used in the Bible in a good sense, while at other times it is used in a bad sense. In Matthew 15 and the parallel in Mark 7 Jesus condemned those traditions which the scribes and Pharisees sought to bind on the people. They transgressed the commandment of God because of their tradition (Mt. 15: 2-3, 6). They laid aside and rejected the commandments of God to keep their tradition (Mk. 7: 8). By their actions they invalidated the word of God (Mk. 7: 13). (Paul and Peter also condemned certain traditions. See Colossians 2: 8 and 1 Peter 1: 18).

Sometimes, however, the Bible speaks positively of traditions. Paul said, "Now I praise you, brethren, that you remember me in all things and keep the traditions just as I delivered them to you" (1 Cor. 11: 2). Again, he said, "Therefore, brethren, stand fast and hold the traditions which you were taught, whether by word or our epistle" (2 Th. 2: 15).

From these verses we conclude that some traditions are good and others are not. The context helps us make the distinction. So why do some try to convince us that all tradition is bad? We need to choose and use words carefully. We need to use words in a way that is in harmony with the word of God.
