## \* Sunday Sermons \*

The sermons today will come from Mark 8. The morning sermon is "Our Most Precious Possession." It is based on Mark 8: 34-38. There are two main points. First there is a summons to discipleship (8:34). Then Jesus discusses the salvation of our souls, our most important possession (8: 35-38).

The evening sermon is "Our Struggle With Satan," based on Mark 8:32-33. Verse 32 deals with Peter's rebuke of Jesus, while verse 33 discusses Jesus' rebuke of Peter. An analysis of this text is followed by an application to us. As Peter struggled with Satan, so do we. Who is Satan? From where did he come? What is his goal? All of these are important questions, and we will try to give a brief answer to each.

Speaking of Satan, David Broome is teaching an excellent Wednesday night class on "Satan and His Tactics." Your time would be well spent in this class. The other Wednesday night class, which I teach, is "Great Doctrines of the Bible." Presently we are studying the question, "Is the Bible the Word of God?" Please be with us on Wednesday nights for devotional and to attend one of these classes.

Have you seen the new bulletin board on Missions in the back hall of the old building? That is the work of Lisa Hilton and she did a great job! We appreciate her work very much. We are excited about our mission efforts.
