A PRAYER

Last Sunday Southern Hills celebrated its twenty-third anniversary. It was a good day. In the sermon I asked three questions about anniversaries. (1) What is an anniversary? (2) Why do we celerate anniversaries? (3) What are we to remember on this anniversary? Then we looked at the importance of remembering as illustrated in Joshua 4: 1-8.

We noted that we are to remember several things. (1) God is our Father. (2) Jesus is our Savior and Lord. (3) The Bible is God's word. (4) We are Christ's church. We also said that we must remember (1) those who made Southern Hills possible, (2) where we have been, (3) where we are now and (4) those who have encouraged us to be faithful to God, His Son and His word.

Finally, we closed the sermon with a prayer for Southern Hills. Here is that prayer. May this great and beautiful church never abandon "the faith once for all time delivered to the saints." May it never lose its conviction in reference to the existence of God, the deity of Christ, the inspired word and the church as the blood-bought body of Christ. May we hold firmly to the plea to restore New Testament Christianity, to speak where the Bible speaks and be silent where the Bible is silent, to do Bible things in Bible ways and call Bible things by Bible names.
