**~ SALVATION ~**

“Sin is man's greatest problem; salvation is man's greatest need.” What is salvation? Salvation from what? Last Sunday morning we studied the problem of sin. Today we examine the solution to the sin problem. The solution to sin is our Savior (Acts 4:12).

Jesus has many names in the Bible, most of which are also titles. He is Jesus, the Savior and Deliverer. He is the Christ, the Messiah, God's Anointed One. He is the Lord or Master. The name we want to focus attention on today is Savior, by which we mean the One who brings salvation. But in order to understand what it means to say that Jesus is our Savior, we must first consider what salvation is. We will study three words: Salvation, Savior and Saves. Why? Because salvation comes from the Savior who saves us from sin. That is the point of this lesson.

What is salvation? It is deliverance or preservation, deliverance from the power and effects of sin or the power and penalty of sin. It is interesting to note that the word salvation, when it appears in the New Testament, is found only in connection with Christ as the Savior.

What does it mean to say that Jesus is the Savior? It means that He is the One who saves us from our sin through His blood shed on the cross (Acts 5:31; 1 Tim. 1:15; 2 Tim. 1:10; Eph. 1:7; Jn. 1:29; Acts 4:12).

What does it mean to say that Jesus saves us? He brings salvation from God to us, He delivers and preserves us (Tit. 2:11-14; Lk. 19:10; Jn. 3:17; Mt. 1:21). Jesus our Savior saves us. He brings salvation to us.
