~ The Grace of God ~

Brother David Lipscomb passed away on November 11, 1917. In the days prior to his death, Lipscomb was often visited by H. Leo Boles, who would succeed him as editor of the Gospel Advocate and president of the Nashville Bible School.

On one such occasion Boles asked Lipscomb, "In what does your hope lie, brother Lipscomb?" Lipscomb replied, "My hope is in the grace of God." What is the grace of God? It is God's unmerited favor toward us. As Ira North so well put it, "Grace is when you get what you don't deserve and you don't get what you do deserve."

This morning our theme is "The Grace of God." We will study Ephesians 2:1-10, one of the greatest Bible passages on this subject. Last week we looked at the love of God. How are the topics of the love and grace of God related? God's grace is the result of his love. The two are inseparable.

First we will discuss our past and what we were like before we became Christians. We were dead, disobedient and doomed (vs. 1-3). Then we will look at God's power and His mercy, love and grace (vs. 4-7). This will be followed by the procedure that brought our salvation (vs. 8-9), and the purpose for which God saved us (v. 10).

This will give us a better and deeper understanding of the grace of God and why His grace is so important. Thank God for His matchless grace!
