*~ More on Evangelism ~*

A great example of evangelism is the story of the encounter of Jesus with the Samaritan woman at the well at Sychar (John 4). The conversation began with Jesus asking the woman for a drink of water. This led to a discussion of "living water" (vs. 10-15). This in turn led to Jesus asking the woman to call her husband. When she replied that she had no husband, Jesus revealed that He knew of her five husbands and the man with whom she was then living.

What is important is that the woman, when she was told by Jesus that He was the Messiah (v. 26), left her waterpot behind and went into the city to tell others about whom she had met. Upon hearing this others came to meet Jesus for themselves (v. 35). The woman was so excited that she forgot her waterpot, a precious utensil in a dry land. Her excitement caused her to tell others about Jesus. This caused them to seek out Jesus for themselves. This was evangelism in action.

Many of the Samaritans first believed in Jesus because of what the woman said (v. 39). However, once they spent time with the Lord, they believed in Him "because of His own word" (v. 41). They said, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world" (v. 42). Evangelism in action. "Go and do likewise!"
