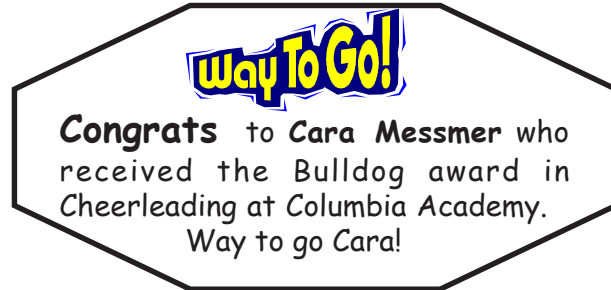
Don't forget about our online study tools. The study tools are found in the members section of the Southern Hills website:

Services for the Hearing Impaired

*The Word Of God (I)*

God has revealed Himself to us in three ways: through nature (Rom. 1:18), His Son (Heb. 1:1-4) and His word (2 Tim. 3:16-17). His word, the Bible, is inspired by Him (2 Tim. 3:16-17; 1 Cor. 2:13-16). He is its Author, Origin and Source. Thus the Bible is God's authoritative revelation to us (Heb. 1:1-4; Jn. 17:17).

The Bible claims to be the inspired and authoritative word of God. As an attorney can put his client on the witness stand to testify in his own behalf, so we can let the Bible make a legitimate claim for itself. Over 3,808 times the Old Testament alone affirms that it is the very word of God. The phrase "it is written" appears in the New Testament over ninety times in reference to God's word. The Bible is "the word of God" (Rom. 9:6).

In 2 Samuel 23:2, in what are called "the last words of David," the shepherd king wrote, "The Spirit of the Lord spoke by me, And His word was on my tongue." David calls God "the God of Israel," and "the Rock of Israel" and says that He "spoke to me." Jeremiah wrote, "Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: Behold, I have put My words in your mouth" (Jer. 1:9).

God "has in these days spoken to us by His Son" (Heb. 1:2). Repeatedly the New Testament says that the Lord spoke through the prophets (Mt. 1:22, 2:15; 2 Pt. 1:16-21). The Bible confirms its inspiration and authority in such passages as 1 Corinthians 2:13-16 and 2 Timothy 3: 16-17. The Bible is the inspired, infallible, inerrant, all-sufficient and completely and totally authoritative word of the living God.
