## ~ THE HOLINESS OF GOD ~

One of the greatest and most basic themes of the entire Bible is the holiness of God. At the heart of man's doubt, disbelief and denial is the fact that we have lost sight of the holiness of God. It is time to turn our attention to that major biblical theme. The God we love and serve is altogether holy.

When Isaiah saw the Lord sitting on His throne he heard the seraphim saying, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!" (Isa. 6:1-3). This prompted the prophet to cry, "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts" (vs. 5-6).

The four living creatures who surrounded the throne of the Lord said, "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come." The twenty-four elders said, "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created" (Rev. 4: 1-11).

Of whom were these speaking? The holy God. To be holy is to be set apart, separate, pure, righteous and godly. God is holy. Holiness is the quality or state of being holy. Those words describe God Almighty. This morning we will do an overview of what the Bible says about the holy God. "I am holy." Tonight we will see that this holy God demands that His children be holy (1 Pet. 1: 13-16).
