THE SOLUTION

In our new series of Sunday morning sermons we saw that the gospel is "the power of God unto salvation" (Rom. 1: 16). Then we saw that "All Scripture is given by the inspiration of God" (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). Last Sunday we saw that the problem is sin (Rom. 3: 23). Today we will begin to look at the solution to the problem: Jesus Christ.

The sermon will consist of four major points. First we will consider the preexistence of Christ. Then we will look at one particular prophecy among the many in the Bible about Christ. This will be followed by a look at the purpose of Christ. Then the final point will show us that Jesus is the only One who is perfectly qualified to be our Savior and Lord.

Tonight in our continuing study of 2 Timothy we will look at Paul's warning against false teachers in 2 Timothy 3: 6-9. I hope you will be here for both of these studies.

As our nation and the world continue to move farther away from God and His word Christians must keep the faith. It would be easy to compromise with the forces of Satan, but God's people must never do that. Even if persecution and discrimination against God and His people continues and intensifies, we must stand firm in the faith. As Paul said, "Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong" (1 Cor. 16: 13). And as someone else said, "Don't keep the faith. Share it!"
