“Preach The Word”

Gospel preachers must “Preach the word!” Why? “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables” (2 Tim. 4: 1-4). Earlier Paul had written, “But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come” (2 Tim. 4: 1).

Why must gospel preachers preach the word? First, because the word is inspired by God (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). The word makes the man or woman of God “complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.” Second, gospel preachers must “hold fast the pattern of sound words” (2 Tim. 1: 13). They do this to present themselves approved to God, “a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth” (2 Tim. 2: 15).

This word must be taught to “others also” (2 Tim. 2: 2), so that all may know the word and will of God. Why is it necessary to know God’s word and will? Because “the Holy Scriptures...are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus” (2 Tim. 3: 15).

It is imperative that we study and come to know the word of God, the Bible. How can we know the words of the Bible without studying the words of the Bible? If you receive a letter from a dear loved one or close friend, do you read it casually or carefully? If you are given a legal document, do you read it closely or casually? We must read and study the Bible closely and carefully because it is from God.
