GRACE

This morning we will examine the biblical doctrine of grace. What is grace? How important is it? First, however, note the relationship between God's grace and God's love and mercy (Eph. 2:1-10). God's grace and mercy are the result of God's love (Jn. 3:16-17). Because God loves us so much, He gave His Son to die for us. He did that, not because we have earned God's grace, nor because we deserve it, but because God loves us. And God extends His mercy to us for the same reason.

H. Leo Boles visited David Lipscomb when Lipscomb was seriously ill. Boles asked Lipscomb, "In what is your hope, brother Lipscomb?" To this Lipscomb replied, "My hope is in the grace of God." So is yours and mine! I once heard Ira North define grace as when "we do get what we don't deserve and we don't get what we do deserve." It is hard to improve on that definition!

This morning (and possibly next Sunday morning) we will study the grace or unmerited favor of God. Our sermons will be based on Titus 2:11-14. I hope you will be here to study both of these lessons.

Tonight we will study the biblical doctrine of hell. We have just finished a series on the final week in the earthly life of Jesus, including His crucifixion and resurrection. That was followed by sermons on His ascension, second coming, the judgement and heaven. This topic will conclude that series. Please be here!
