*~ The Son Of God ~*

The Bible clearly teaches that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. First, the Bible affirms His eternal nature (Jn. 1:1-4; Gen. 1:1, 26-27). "He was in the beginning with God" (Jn. 1:2). Second, it was prophesied that He would come (Psalm 22; Isaiah 53; Isaiah 7:14). Third, it was promised that He would come (Mt. 1:18-23). Fourth, He was affirmed to be the Son of God by the voice of God and descent of the Holy Spirit (Mt. 3:16-17). Fifth, He was again affirmed to be the Son of God at His transfiguration (Mt. 17:1-5). Sixth, Peter confessed Him to be the Son of God (Mt. 16:16). Seventh, His miracles confirmed His Sonship (Jn. 20:30-31). Eighth, His death confirmed who He was (Mk. 8:31; 9:31; 10:32-34). Ninth, His resurrection declared Him to be the Son of God (Rom. 1:4). Tenth, His ascension to the right hand of God confirms who He is (Ps. 110:1; Acts 2:32-36).

In this day of postmodern political correctness it is considered proper to say that there are many routes to salvation and heaven. However, that is certainly not the teaching of the Bible. Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. God has spoken to us in Him. Therefore, we are to hear, obey and follow Him. He is the Savior.

That is exactly what Jesus said in John 14:6. "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." We can follow either the philosophy of the world or the truth of God's word. Which will it be?
