KEEP THE FAITH

The Apostle Paul encouraged Timothy to “Preach the word!” (2 Tim. 4:2). Why? Because “the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine” (2 Tim. 4: 3). That time has come! “The faith which was once for all delivered to the saints” (Jd. 3) is being assaulted from every side. As Paul predicted, false teachers have come from both without and within (Acts 20: 28-30).

What is the duty (and privilege) of the Christian? To keep the faith (2 Tim. 4:7). Paul had fought the good fight, finished the race and kept the faith. So must we!

When the term “the faith” appears in Scripture, it refers to that body of doctrine that we know as the “truth” (Jn. 17: 17; Jn. 8:32). It refers to God’s word, the Bible (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). The gospel is called “the good deposit (2 Tim. 1:14), “that treasure” (2 Cor. 4: 7), “the faith” (Jd. 3), “the word” (2 Tim. 4: 2), and “sound words” (2 Tim. 1: 13).

This faith is to be committed “to faithful men who will be able to teach others also” (2 Tim. 2: 2). There is nothing more important than our obedience to the truth and the teaching of it to others. God’s truth is under attack. We must “Fight the good fight of faith” (1 Tim. 6: 12). Let it be said that the Southern Hills church will always “contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all (time) delivered to the saints” (Jd. 3).
