## ~ Man's Greatest Burden ~

We feel the weight of our burdens pressing on us and they cause us to despair. The burdens of fear, failure, rejection, heartache, heartbreak and others weigh us down. But there is one burden that outweighs all the others and that is the burden of sin. It is a burden that not only hinders and cripples us, it is the burden that can ultimately destroy us spiritually and eternally. What does the Bible teach about the burden of sin?

For one thing it is "heavy" and causes us to be "heavy laden" (Mt. 11: 28-30). "All have sinned" (Rom. 3: 23) and "the wages of sin is death" (Rom. 6: 23). "Death has passed to all men, for all have sinned" (Rom. 5:12). But not only can sin lead to physical death. More importantly, it leads to spiritual death (Js. 1: 12-16).

Further, sin is the weapon used by the devil to destroy us (Pr. 14: 34; 1 Cor. 10: 1-12). Sin caused Christ to die on the cross; not His sins (Heb. 4: 15), but ours (2 Cor. 5: 21; 1 Pet. 2: 24). Every sin is against God (1 Jn. 3: 4; Heb. 6: 4-6; Ps. 51: 4).

God's solution to the burden of sin is Christ (Jn. 3: 16-17). He died for us when we were ungodly (Rom. 5: 8). Through Christ God has given us the opportunity to have a "new birth" (Jn. 3: 1-5). We can have "newness of life" (Rom. 6: 4) and become a "new creation" (2 Cor. 5: 17; Eph. 4: 22-24). We can have "redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins" (Eph. 1: 7; Col. 1: 14). Why do you not obey the gospel of Christ and be freed from the burden of sin?
