~ Discipleship ~

What is discipleship? What is a disciple? A disciple is a pupil, student and learner. He is one who follows the teachings, philosophy, practices and way of life of a teacher. The teacher for Christians is Jesus the Christ. He is the example by which we model our lives (Phil. 2: 5-11). Our lives are a living confession of Matthew 16: 16. Our lives declare that Jesus is "the Christ, the Son of the living God." In the New Testament "Christian" and "disciple" are synonymous terms (Acts 11: 26).

Christian discipleship demands commitment to Christ. As J.B. Phillips put it, "A man must give up all rights to himself." This demand is made by the One who went to the cross for us (1 Pt. 2: 24). Therefore, He has every right to make this demand. And this demand is made of all who follow Him. There are no exceptions; it is universal. "He summoned the crowd with His disciples" (Mark 8: 34).

What are the demands of discipleship? First, we are to desire to be disciples of Jesus. The NKJV says, "Whoever desires to come after Me" (Mk. 8: 34). One who becomes an elder must "desire" the office (1 Tim. 3: 1). Even so, one who becomes a disciple of Christ must have to desire to do so.

Secondly, the one who desires to be a disciple must "deny himself." Thirdly, he must "take up his cross." Then and only then is one ready to follow Him. Then one is ready to be a disciple. Are you willing to meet the demands for discipleship?
