Sermon Studies



Our Sunday morning sermons are expository studies of 1 Thessalonians. These sermons follow an expository series on Galatians. The church at Thessalonica was a good church even with its problems. In some ways it was a great church. We are examining the reasons why.

The Sunday evening sermons are devoted to an expository study of the Gospel of Mark. We have seen many important things about Jesus from Mark's gospel account. He is the Son of God (Mk. 1:1). He came to serve and give His life as a ransom for many (Mk. 10:45). In addition, one of the key themes of Mark is the authority of Jesus (Mk. 1:27). At a time when many see Jesus as at best one great religious leader among many and one of many ways to God, we need to know what the Bible teaches about Jesus (Jn. 14:6).

Those in the Wednesday night auditorium Bible class have been studying the question, "Is the Bible the word of God?" Our studies have answered that question in the affirmative. The Bible is the inspired, inerrant, infallible, all-sufficient and completely and totally authoritative word of the living and true God (1 Th. 1:9; 2 Tim. 3:16-17). The Sunday morning auditorium Bible class is a verse-by-verse study of Romans. This week we will study Romans 4. There are several excellent Bible classes on both Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.

Please bring your Bible and study with us. You will be glad you did!
